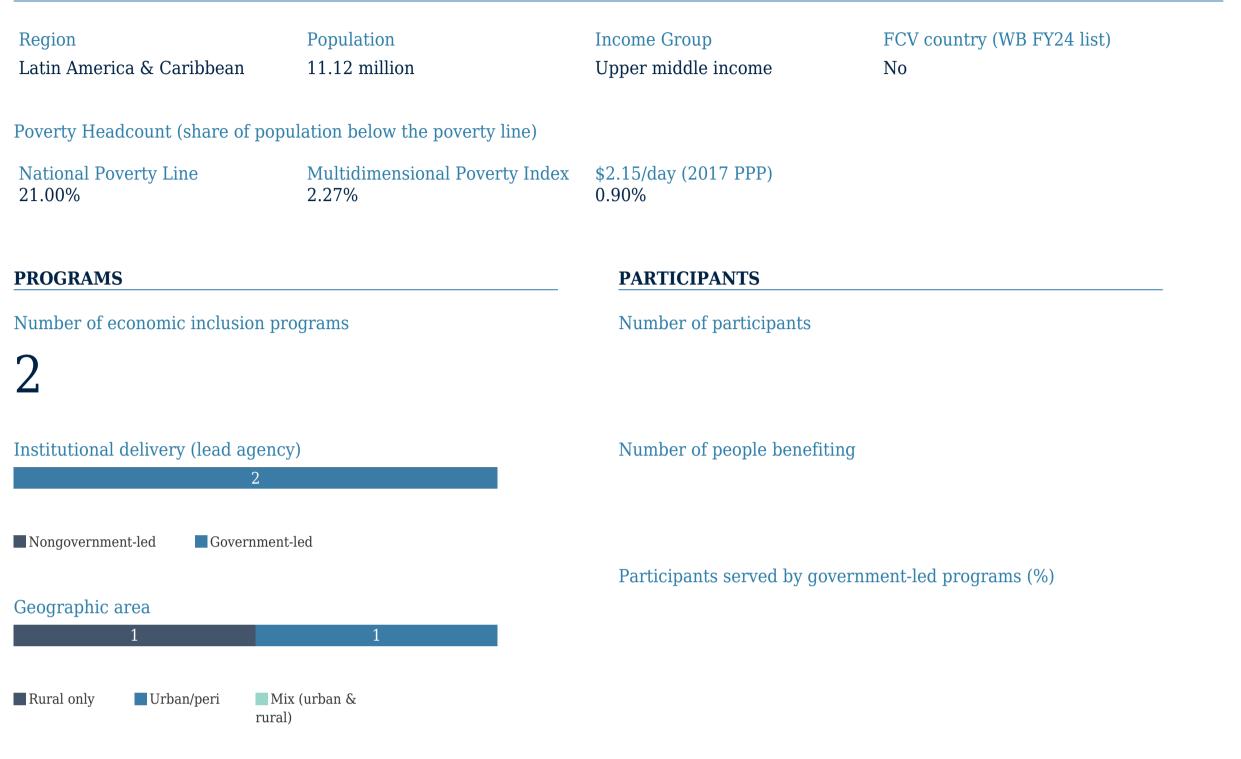
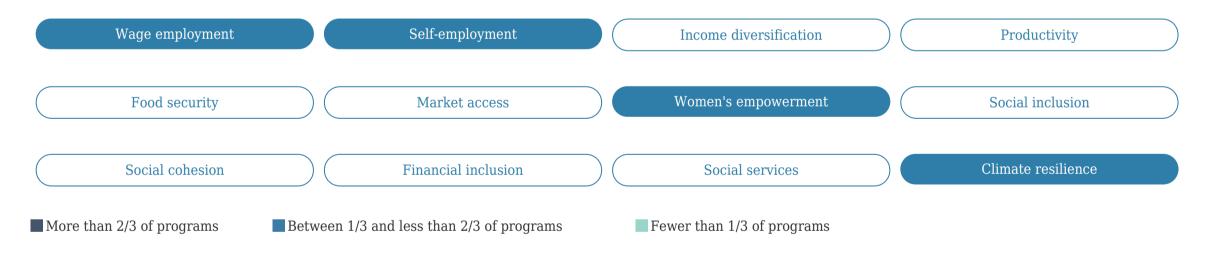
# **Dominican Republic**

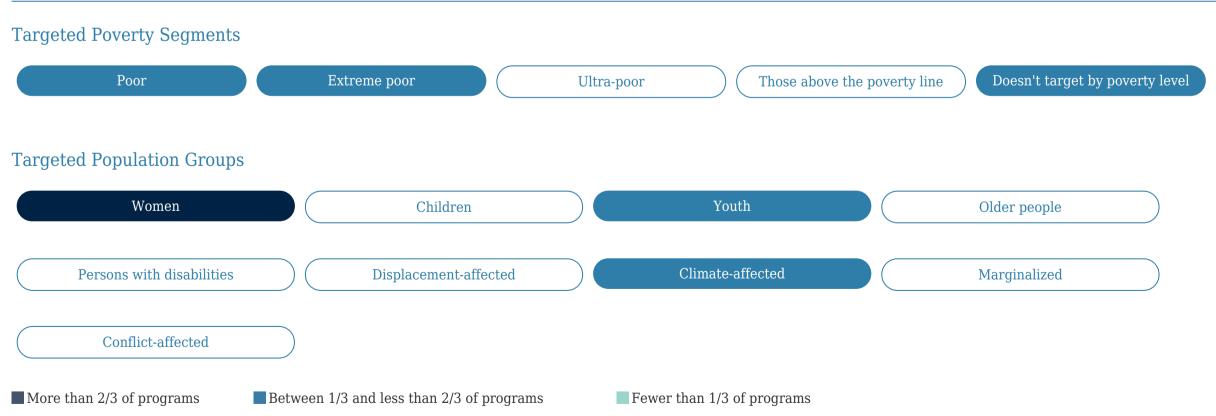
